- TIP Thoroughbred 2'6" Division (To run concurrently with class #36, #37, #38)
- \$50 TIP Thoroughbred Hunter Classic 3' (To run concurrently with class #48)
- Hunter High Point Thoroughbred – Low (below 3'0")
- Hunter High Point Thoroughbred – High (3'0" and above)
- \$50 Hunter High Point Thoroughbred Award



TIP Jumper Classes and Awards (TIP entries will be placed separately):
