## **USEA YOUNG EVENT HORSE (YEH) RULES OVERVIEW**

### **DRESSAGE - 30% OF FINAL SCORE**

**Dressage will be judged on overall collective impressions, not by each individual movement.**

- Scored on the walk, trot, canter, and rideability.
- Horses leaving the arena during test will not be eliminated and are encouraged to continue, but receive a reduced score for rideability.

### **JUMPING TEST/GALLOP/GENERAL IMPRESSION - 70% OF FINAL SCORE**

- There must be five (5) show jumps (#1-5) and ten (10) cross-country fences (#6-15), 15 total jumps.

Scoring 0.0-5.0 with 0.5 decimal points allowed with each fence receiving a score based:

0 - Refusal; 1 - Very Bad; 2 - Bad; 3 - Satisfactory; 4 - Good; 5 - Excellent; Rail Down - no higher score than 2

**Horses will be evaluated in the following areas:**

- Jumping technique and scope
- Rideability, i.e. confidence, response to the aids, attitude and learning ability
- Between fences, i.e. maintaining a rhythm, appropriate pace, desire to go forward, ability to adjust balance before the fence, and jumping out of stride
- Open Gallop, i.e. desire to go forward, ground cover, balance, ease and efficiency of the gallop;
- Potential as a four or five-star event horse.
